This very unusual and interesting name is of Old French origin, introduced into England by the Normans after the Conquest of 1066. Cryer, and its variant form Crier, is an occupational surname for a town crier, one who was employed to make public announcements in a loud voice; this was usually an appointment made by the local court of justice. The name derives from the Old French and Middle English "criere" the nominative of "crieur", crier, a derivative of the verb "crier", to cry aloud, from the Latin "Quiritate". The development of the surname has included the following examples: Robert le Crieur (1269, Northumberland), Johanna Cryour (1379, Yorkshire), and Alicia Crioure (1379, *ibid*). Among the recordings of the name in London is that of the marriage of John Cryer and Mary Stermore, at St. James's, Duke's Place, on November 9th 1679. The first recorded spelling of the family name is shown to be that of Geoffrey le Criur, which was dated 1221, in the "Hertfordshire Curia Rolls", during the reign of King Henry 111, known as "The Frenchman", 1216 - 1272.

name: YARKER; origins:  
There appear to be two origins for this very interesting name. The first is from Yorkshire where the term 'to yark' is still in use, and means 'to pull' and was applied to the official of the local Court sent to arrest wrong doers, and also known as the 'whipper in'. The second is from the Midlands and West Country and is a medieval job description for a person who sewed the uppers to the soles of shoes! The first recorded spelling of the family name is shown to be that of John Le Yorker. which was dated 1327, The Pipe Rolls of Cambridge. during the reign of King Edward 111 The Father of the Navy 1327 -1377. Surnames became necessary when governments introduced personal taxation.
